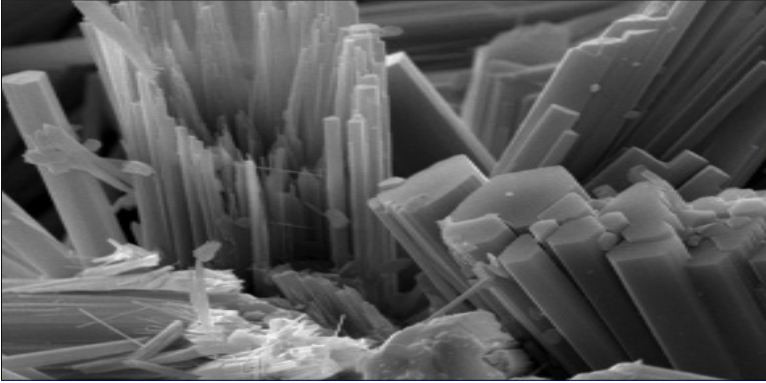

- Sampling techniques for NOA/Erionite in soil/rock
 - Incremental sampling
- Analysis techniques for NOA/ Erionite
 - XRD, PLM, TEM, PCM, SEM, FBAS
- Strategy on managing occurrences of NOA/Erionite
 - Wet controls, limit personnel, training, etc.
- Best management practices for minimizing exposures to workers, reduce off-site tracking of materials and long-term management.
